1. **ANNOUNCEMENT:**
The Crystal Brook Motorcycle Club Inc. hereafter called the PROMOTER or ORGANISERS will conduct round 1 of the "2017 SA Vintage Motocross CHAMPIONSHIPS" for Senior Solos at Crystal Brook on Sunday 11th June 2017.
2. **JURISDICTION:**
The abovementioned meeting has been authorised by Motorcycling SA Inc. which has issued the Motorcycling Australia Permit Number C17087 & to holders of current Motorcycling Australia Senior and Junior National Licences.
2.1 A Senior "One Meeting Licence" of \$75 also applies to this event.
2.2 The meeting will be held in accordance with the current Manual of Motorcycle Sports (MoMS) these Supplementary Regulations & any final instructions approved by Motorcycling SA Inc.
BY ENTERING THIS MEETING ALL PARTIES AGREE TO COMPLY WITH THESE RULES, REGULATIONS, BY-LAWS AND INSTRUCTIONS.
3. **ENTRIES:**
 - 3.1 Entries are available online
 - 3.2 In the case of postponement or abandonment of the meeting, all or any part of the entry fee may be retained by the Promoter / Organiser, if such retention is approved by Motorcycling SA Inc.
THERE MUST BE 4 COMPETITORS TO CONSTITUTE A STATE TITLE CLASS - UNDER 4 COMPETITORS WILL BE SUPPORT CLASSES ONLY.
 - 3.3 Only entries received on the official entry form accompanied by the correct fee will be accepted.
 - 3.4 The organisers reserve the right to refuse entries, combine classes & alter the program to suit entries and/or conditions on the day.
 - 3.5 **NOTE: LATE ENTRIES MAY NOT BE ACCEPTED & THE RETURN OF ENTRY FEES FOR ANY RIDER WITHDRAWING FROM THE MEETING IS AT THE DISCRETION OF THE ORGANISERS.**
4. **INSURANCE:**
 - 4.1 National Personal Accident Scheme provides basic cover for death and permanent disability.
 - 4.2 Ambulance Insurance is compulsory for licensees.
 - 4.3 **IT IS STRONGLY RECOMMENDED THAT COMPETITORS GIVE CONSIDERATION TO TAKING OUT WEEKLY BENEFITS INSURANCE.**
5. **MEDICAL SERVICES:**
Medical personnel will be in attendance and provided by ACTFAST.
6. **ENTRY FEES:**
 - 6.1 **STATE TITLE CLASSES: - MUST ALL HAVE A CURRENT MA LICENCE or a SENIOR "ONE MEETING LICENCE" & APPLICABLE TO STATE TITLE CLASSES ONLY, \$75 - plus entry fee.**
THIS LICENCE MUST BE APPLIED FOR VIA RACE SECRETARY AT LEAST 21 DAYS BEFORE THIS EVENT - (see 2017 MoMS)

 EXTRA BIKES & CLASSES \$10.00

- 6.2 Payment by Cheque and Money Orders only. ANY FEES FOR DISHONOURD CHEQUES WILL BE THE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE RIDER.
- 6.3 Cheques and Money Orders are to be made payable & sent to the Race Secretary.

7. **ENTRY PASSES:**
NOT REQUIRED

8. **CLASSES OF COMPETITION & RACE FORMATS:** (CLASSES A – K, ARE STATE TITLE CLASSES) – Subject to rider entry numbers.
STATE TITLE EVENTS – SENIORS ONLY - pre 1975, pre 1978, pre 1985, pre 1990 & Evolution class.
ALL SENIOR RIDERS/PASSENGERS MUST HAVE FULL MA NATIONAL LICENCES OR A ONE DAY HISTORIC LICENCE FOR THESE CLASSES.

9. **AWARDS AND PRIZEMONEY:**

Points will be given as per the 25 point system. 1st, 2nd & 3rd placings from highest accumulated points on the day will be awarded sashes.
A presentation night for series trophies will be announced later in the series.
Support classes will be awarded prizes on the day. 1st 2nd 3rd.

10. **ENTRIES TO CONSTITUTE A CLASS:**

10.1 **AS PER MSA RULES, THERE MUST BE 4 CLASSIC COMPETITORS TO CONSTITUTE A STATE TITLE CLASS –
UNDER 4 COMPETITORS WILL BE A SUPPORT CLASS ONLY.**

10.2 If there are insufficient entries in any class of competition the decision to run or cancel the class or to combine events and re-distribute any awards will be at the discretion of the organisers.

11. **MACHINES AND RIDERS:**

- 11.1 All machines entered must comply with the current MoMS for Classic & Modern motocross competition.
11.2 Multiple entry of the one machine in the same class of competition is not permitted.
11.3 Any person other than officials are not permitted inside the circuit at any time whilst the meeting is in progress.
11.4 A lanyard operated cut out (kill switch) which will stop the engine and isolate the battery if the rider falls from the machine, must be fitted to all sidecars.
11.5 **ALL MIRRORS, SIDE AND CENTRE STANDS MUST BE REMOVED. HELMET FITTED CAMERAS & TEAR OFFS ARE PROHIBITED.**
11.6 Please replace headlight front with an approved number plate if there is no appropriate place for an easily read number.
11.7 Eligibility will be as per current MoMS. For definition of all machinery refer to current MoMS.
11.8 Number Plates, Background Colours and Figures to comply with current MoMS.

12. **GRID POSITIONS:**

To be advised at Rider Briefing.

13. **RIDERS' BRIEFING:**

A riders' briefing will be held prior to the commencement of racing at approx. **8.45am**, which **ALL COMPETITORS MUST ATTEND.**
NON ATTENDANCE WILL RESULT IN NO RIDING.

14. **DRUG AND/OR ALCOHOL TESTING:**

14.1 All competitors and officials are advised that as part of the MA and MSA drug education program, drug testing may take place at any competition in accordance with Australian Sports Commission policy as implemented by the Australian Sports Anti-Doping Authority and the Motorcycling SA Drug and Alcohol Policy.

14.2 If any doubts exist over banned substances it is recommended competitors contact the Drugs in Sport Hotline, tel 1800 020 506. When drug testing takes place, the payment of prize money/trophies may be delayed at the Motorcycling SA Inc. discretion until the results of the tests are known.

14.3 For the purposes of drug and alcohol testing, the commencement of the meeting will be deemed to be 7:30am with the completion of the meeting for the participant being when the participant has vacated the venue.

15. **CODE OF CONDUCT:**

All competitors, officials and parents are reminded of the Motorcycling Australia by-law - CODE OF CONDUCT (as stipulated in the current MoMS), which is a guide to appropriate behaviour at all motorcycle race meetings. This CODE OF CONDUCT applies to this meeting and will be enforced.

16. **TIMETABLE:**
SIGN ON/SCRUTINEERING - Sunday 7:30am - 8:30am.
** All riders and passengers whether open or demonstration class must present current National MA Licence & Log book (Juniors only) to Sign In. Riders must also come dressed in full riding gear **SHOWING RIDING NUMBERS ON THEIR BACK** to Scrutineering with bike/s.
- RIDER'S BRIEFING - approx 8.45am.**
- PRACTICE** - straight after rider briefing using a roster system.
- RACING begins - at completion of practice.**
17. **CIRCUIT DESCRIPTION:**
Purpose built circuit with natural terrain, man-made jumps & berms. All classes, both classic and modern will use the same track.
18. **STARTS:**
All starts will be by drop gates.
19. **RACING:**
As per class and racing format section.
Important Information for Junior Riders:
Logbooks – Junior riders **MUST** hand their Log Book in at Sign On & collect when finished racing.
20. **SPECIAL NOTES AND WARNINGS:**
- 20.1 **All riders both Juniors & Seniors MUST have back numbers as per MoMS.**
- 20.2 The carrying or consumption of alcoholic beverages is not permitted in the pit area.
- 20.3 No smoking in the pit area.
- 20.4 No animals allowed. Exception for Guide or Assistance Dogs.
- 20.5 Camping is permitted at Crystal Brook track from Saturday afternoon.
- 20.6 Full catering will be available from Sunday morning.
- 20.7 **Riders must supply an abled bodied flag person over 16 years to assist. No flaggy – No Ride - A roster for flag marshals will be supplied.**
21. **NOISE: Please note: Changes have been implemented..**
- 21.1 Noise emission levels have been changed - with the 2m max method, the limit is 112 with a 4dB/A allowance.
- 21.2 Competitors maybe required to undergo a static noise test during the event.
- 21.3 No person may compete in any event on a machine whose emissions exceed the limits as noted in MOMs.
- 21.4 If a machine fails it can be presented for re-testing several times.
