**1. ANNOUNCEMENT:**

The Mount Gambier Motor Cycle Club Inc. hereafter called the PROMOTER will conduct interclub road racing at McNamara Park, on 31<sup>st</sup> March & 1<sup>st</sup> April 2018

**2. JURISDICTION:**

The above-mentioned meeting has been authorised by Motorcycling SA Inc. which has issued the Motorcycling Australia Permit Number C18034 All riders must be holders of a current MA National License. 13-year-old competitors with Junior Licenses endorsed for Road Racing and to ride with Seniors in the 125ccGP/250ccGP Class and are also eligible to enter. The race meeting will also be open to junior riders 9 to under 12,70ccManual and 11-under 15 years of age with solo machines 80cc 2 stroke and 160cc 4 stroke & have completed compulsory 5 hours coaching. Junior riders must hold a National License. Club ,Officials and Coaches reserve the right to refuse a Junior entry if they feel that Junior riding with Seniors (even if endorsed) is not capable or safe.

All riders must be **either** holders of a current M.A. National licence **or** must take out a one-event licence for the meeting. Riders in the latter category must have previous road race experience or have passed a licence testing application prior to the meeting (this can be organised by contacting the MGMC 0448 951 163 or by contacting a Club near you). Application for a one-event license must be made simultaneously with submission of entry form and issue of the licence is conditional upon the rider competing in only those events and on those machines as specified in the entry form. The issue of one-event licences will be at the discretion of the Secretary of Meeting, with right of appeal to the Steward as per GCR's.

2.2. The meeting will be held in accordance with the current General Competition Rules (GCR's) Manual of Motorcycle Sport (MoMs) these Supplementary Regulations, and any final instructions approved by Motorcycling SA Inc.

- 3.1. In the case of postponement or abandonment of the meeting, all or any part of the entry fee may be retained by the Mt Gambier Motor Cycle Club Inc., if such retention is approved by Motorcycling SA Inc.
- 3.2. Only entries received on the official entry form that is accompanied by the correct fee will be accepted.
- 3.3. **NOTE: - LATE ENTRIES AND ENTRIES WITHOUT PAYMENT WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED AND THE RETURN OF ENTRY FEES FOR ANY RIDER WITHDRAWING FROM THE MEETING IS AT THE DISCRETION OF THE CLUB.**
4. **INSURANCE:**
  - 4.1. National Personal Accident Scheme provides basic cover for death and permanent disability.
  - 4.2. **Ambulance Insurance is compulsory for licensees.**
  - 4.3. **IT IS STRONGLY RECOMMENDED THAT COMPETITORS GIVE CONSIDERATION TO TAKING OUT WEEKLY BENEFITS INSURANCE.**
5. **MEDICAL SERVICES:**

7. **ENTRY PASSES:**  
Each Solo Rider entered shall receive 2 passes for each day.  
Participants quoting a current Entrants Licence shall receive 1 extra pass for each day.  
Additional passes may be ordered on the entry form.  
No passes required for Friday practice

## 8 CLASSES OF COMPETITION

### SENIORS

**Superbikes** - 4 stroke over 600 cc 4-cyl, over 675cc 3-cyl & over 750cc 2-cyl machines complying with MoMs 2018. Tyre choice open. Grid positions will be taken from qualifying sessions held on Saturday morning. Any rider unable to qualify will start rear of grid. A single point will be awarded for taking pole position.

**Supersport** - 4 stroke 600cc 4-cyl, 675cc 3-cyl & 750cc 2-cyl machines complying with MoMs 2018. Tyre choice open. Grid positions will be taken from qualifying sessions held on Saturday morning. Any rider unable to qualify will start rear of grid. A single point will be awarded for taking pole position.

**Pre Modern:** Open to all grades. Motorcycles must be fitted with an original compliance plate indicating that the date of manufacture is before January 1st 2006 and all major components (motor, frame, wheels and brakes) as commonly available within that period.

**Naked Bike Class:** Open to all grades with no restriction to engine size. Bike must be designed from factory as a "naked bike". Sport bikes with fairings removed are not allowed.

**Limited** - 2 Stroke and 4 Stroke multi-cylinder machines up to 400cc are eligible, twin cylinder machines to 650cc (to 750cc 2 valve only) and single cylinder machines up to 800cc. Riders of 125ccGP, 250GP and 250cc Production machines are encouraged to participate. Grid positions will be taken from qualifying sessions held on Saturday morning. Any rider unable to qualify will start rear of grid. A single point will be awarded for taking pole position.

**JUNIORS** - Grid positions will be taken from qualifying sessions to be held on Saturday morning. Any rider unable to qualify will start rear of grid.

**Nippers** - Up to 70cc machines as per 2018 MoM's Competitors must be aged from 9yrs to under 12 yrs.

Junior 2- Up to 85cc 2 stroke machines as per 2018 MoM's Competitors must be aged 11 to under 15 yrs.

Junior 4- Up to 160cc 4 stroke machines as per 2018 MoM's. Competitors must be ages 11 to under 15 yrs.

125GP- 125GP machines as per 2018 MoM's maybe run with Limited. Must be endorsed to ride with Seniors

250Mono- 250 Four stroke, single cylinder machines as per 2018 MoM's Maybe run with Limited. Must be endorsed to ride with Seniors.

**National BEARS Challenge:** Australian BEARS will compete in F1, 2, 3, 4 & 5 as specified by the Australian BEARS Club. To gain points in this series competitors must use approved tyres (As per BEARS rules 2018) Formula specs can be found at [www.ozbearsracing.com](http://www.ozbearsracing.com) or by contacting Scott Brown 0427 536223. Any rider unable to qualify will start rear of grid. Please Note: BEARS have a rolling grid.

**FEATURE RACES:** The Club will conduct the following feature races:

**Easter Cup-** Open to invited A, B & selected C grade riders on machines of 600cc and above at the discretion of the Club. Grid positions will be from times set in qualifying on Saturday. No juniors or historic machines will be allowed to compete in this feature race. A single point will be awarded for taking pole position.

**Consolation Easter Cup -** Open to riders not selected for Easter Cup at the discretion of the Club. Grid positions will be from times set in qualifying on Saturday. No juniors or historic machines will be allowed to compete in this feature race.

## 9. AWARDS

(See table at end of Sup Regs.)

**Trophies** Will be awarded according to the following numbers of competitors:

Races of where there is one entrant only in a class, no award/trophy will be awarded

Second and third overall points scorers receive trophies unless indicated otherwise and according to the following numbers of competitors: 2 to 3 competitors - first only;

Races of 4 to 6 competitors - first and second,

Races of 7 or more competitors – first, second and third.

Number of award/trophies per class will be based on numbers at official close of entries. No late entries will be accepted

**Period of Holding Awards** – Awards to be picked up at the Presentation Ceremony following the race meeting. If you are unable to attend the ceremony, please nominate someone to collect for you.

Awards/Trophies will not be held.

## 10. ENTRIES TO CONSTITUTE A CLASS:

Should there be insufficient entries in any class of competition; the decision to run or cancel the class, or to combine events and re-distribute any awards will be at the discretion of the club, subject to Motorcycling SA Inc. approval.

## 11 RACE FORMAT:

- 11.1 All machines entered must comply with the current MoMs for Road Race competition. Attention is drawn to the following points.
- 11.2 All modern machines must have engine end case protectors fitted as per MoMs.
- 11.3 Multiple entry of the one machine in the same class of competition is not permitted.
- 11.4 CHANGE TO SPARE/ WET BIKE: Bike must have been entered on official entry form before close of entries. Bike must be scrutineered. Changing of transponder from one bike to another is the responsibility of the rider. If no transponder rider will be black flagged. Once rider has entered track cannot change to spare/wet bike. If a red flag situation arises and a full restart is required the rider has the option of changing bikes, unless rider has caused red flag and is governed by MoMs.
- 11.5 **Spare machines MUST be entered and scrutineered at official scrutineering.**
- 11.6 Bikes cannot be changed halfway through a race
- 11.7 Wherever possible, competitors will be allocated their registered riding numbers or their preferred riding number. All others will be allocated numbers at the Club's discretion.
- 11.8 All number plates on all machines MUST comply with MoMs.

## 12 GRID POSITIONS:

- 12.1 For all classes starting positions will be determined by timed Qualifying Sessions on Saturday 31st March 2018. Combined classes in feature races may get an extra qualifying session if deemed necessary by the club. If unable to take part in Qualifying on Saturday morning, you will not be eligible for feature races. If unable to qualify for scratch (legs) starting position for races on Saturday and Sunday will be at rear of grid.
- 12.2 BEARS starting positions will be determined by timed Qualifying Sessions on Saturday 31st March 2018 and then rolling grids throughout the weekend.

## 13 RIDERS' BRIEFING:

A riders' briefing will be held prior to the commencement of racing, which ALL competitors MUST attend. All riders MUST sign in at Riders Brief to be held on Saturday 31<sup>st</sup> March 2018 at 8.15am at the Clubrooms.

**14 DRUG AND OR ALCOHOL TESTING:**

- 14.1 All competitors and officials are advised that as part of the MA and MSA drug education program, drug testing may take place at any competition in accordance with Australian Sports Commission policy as implemented by the Australian Sports Drug Agency and the Motorcycling SA Drug and Alcohol Policy.
- 14.2 If any doubts exist over banned substances it is recommended competitors contact the Drugs in Sport Hotline, ph: 1800 020 506. When drug testing takes place, the payment of prize money may be delayed at the Motorcycling SA Inc. discretion until the results of the tests are known.

**15 CODE OF CONDUCT:**

All competitors, officials and parents are reminded of the Motorcycling Australia by-law - CODE OF CONDUCT (as stipulated in the MoMs), which is a guide to appropriate behaviour at all motorcycle race meetings. This CODE OF CONDUCT applies to this Meeting and will be enforced.

**16 TIMETABLE:**

Saturday 31<sup>st</sup> March 2018 7-30am- 9am Scrutineering. Qualifying session per class. Racing to commence after qualifying.

Sunday 1<sup>st</sup> April 2018– Limited practice from 9am with racing to follow.

For the purposes of drug and alcohol testing, the commencement of the meeting will be deemed to be **7:30am Saturday** with the completion of the meeting for the participant being a half hour after the last event.

**17 CIRCUIT DESCRIPTION:**

Races will be conducted on a sealed course of 2.4 Km in a clockwise direction.

**18 STARTS:**

All races will be clutch start. Starting will be by lights; RED - for prepare to start, RED light off - for start. An amber light will flash if a start is aborted.

**19 RACING:**

All heats, races and laps for all Classes as laid out in "Awards" table at the end of Sup Regs.

**20 NOISE:**

As Per MoMs

**21 GST:**

The Goods and Services Tax affects the payment of prizemoney. If you do not provide an ABN or declare the sport is a hobby, the Promoter must withhold 48.5% of prizemoney over \$50.00 which is otherwise payable to you. Please tick one of the boxes on the entry form and if appropriate provide your ABN to ensure the full amount of prize money is paid to you.

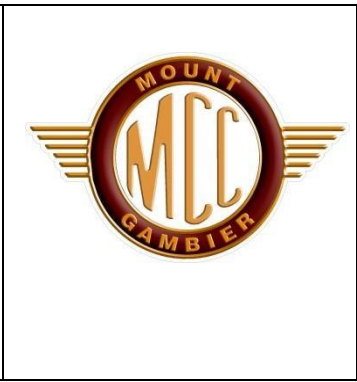
**22 SPECIAL NOTES AND WARNINGS:**

- 22.1 Pit Enclosure – The pit enclosure is a dead engine area, except the bitumised entry & exit roads.
- 22.2 **NO BURNOUTS within the entire property-** PENALTIES APPLY STARTING AT \$500 and or loss of points at the discretion of the Club.
- 22.3 Scrutineering – All riders must wear racing apparel, all machines with fairings must have the belly pan removed and all old scrutineering stickers must be removed.
- 22.4 Garages – A limited number of powered garages 1-36 & 43-54 available in the pit area at \$70 per bay for the weekend. One bay per entry. (Comfortably fits 2 bikes) Sheds 37-42 are available at \$130 per bay for the weekend. Only one bay per entry. (Comfortably fits 4 bikes) Bookings will only be accepted on receipt of Entry form when accompanied by full payment
- 22.5 **Timing:** Timing will be electronic, and EACH machine will be allocated a transponder; the hire charges are included in the entry fee. Riders will be responsible for the safe return of their transponders and a fee will be charged for loss or damage. Before transponders are handed over, competitors will need to provide security of \$50 either cash or Credit Card information to the hirer at the track. The security will be handed back when the transponders are returned in good order to the hirer.
- 22.7 Camping – Bushland style camping is available for a fee of \$10 per person per day. Under 16 free. Camping can commence 4pm Wednesday 28<sup>th</sup> March 2018 till 10am Monday 2<sup>nd</sup> April 2018.
- 22.8 **NO ALCOHOL PERMITTED IN THE PIT AREA AS PER MoMs**
- 22.9 **NO ANIMALS PERMITTED WITHIN THE CIRCUIT BOUNDARY AS PER GCR'S.**
- 22.10 **UNATTENDED CHILDREN ARE THE RESPONSIBILITY OF THEIR PARENTS.**
