1. **ANNOUNCEMENT:**
 The Keyneton MCC, hereafter called the PROMOTER will conduct the 44th Mountain Man Trial at Eden Valley on the June 18th 2017
2. **JURISDICTION:**
 - 2.1. The abovementioned meeting has been authorised by Motorcycling SA Inc which has issued the Motorcycling Australia Permit Number C17072 and is open to holders of current Motorcycling Australia National Open Senior/Junior, Restricted National Licences, plus Recreation and One Event Licences.
 - 2.2. The meeting will be held in accordance with the current General Competition Rules (GCR's), these Supplementary Regulations, and any final instructions approved by Motorcycling SA Inc.
BY ENTERING THIS MEETING ALL PARTIES AGREE TO COMPLY WITH THESE RULES, REGULATIONS, BY-LAWS AND INSTRUCTIONS.
3. **ENTRIES:**
 - 3.1. Entries open forthwith and close last mail Wednesday, June 14th @ 6.00pm.
 - 3.2. Only entries received on the official entry form that is accompanied by the correct fee will be accepted.
 - 3.3. Entries are to be sent to: PO Box 563 Angaston, 5353
 - 3.4. **NOTE:- LATE ENTRIES MAY RECEIVE A 20 POINT PENALTY. THE RETURN OF ENTRY FEES FOR ANY RIDER WITHDRAWING FROM THE MEETING IS AT THE DISCRETION OF THE KEYNETON MCC.**
4. **INSURANCE:**
 - 4.1. National Personal Accident Scheme provides basic cover for death and permanent disability.
 - 4.2. Ambulance Insurance is compulsory for licensees.
 - 4.3. **IT IS STRONGLY RECOMMENDED THAT COMPETITORS GIVE CONSIDERATION TO TAKING OUT WEEKLY BENEFITS INSURANCE.**
5. **MEDICAL SERVICES:**
 First Aid volunteer will be available on site. No Doctor, Paramedic or Ambulance will be in attendance.
6. **ENTRY FEES:**
 - 6.1. Competitive, Solo \$55.00, Sidecar \$95.00, Junior \$30.00, Family rates; additional Adult \$50.00 each, additional Juniors \$25.00 each.
A 'junior entrant' is classed as a full time student living at home – proof may be asked for at events!
 - 6.2. Non Competitive, Solo \$50.00, Sidecar \$80.00
 - 6.3. Online entries at <http://trialsport.com.au/entries>
 - 6.4. If entering on the day a \$5 per rider charge **may** apply.
 - 6.5. Payment by Direct Deposit, Cash, Cheque or Money Order only
 - 6.6. **ANY FEES FOR DISHONOURD CHEQUES WILL BE THE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE ENTRANT.**
 - 6.7. **IF PAYING ON THE DAY IS SELECTED YOU MAY STILL BE LIABLE FOR THE ENTRY FEE IF YOU DO NOT ATTEND.**
 - 6.8. Cheques and Money Orders are to be made payable to the KEYNETON MCC Inc.
 - 6.9. If requiring a 1 Event Rec Licence, add \$30.00 (per rider) to your entry fee, licence to be collected on the morning of the event.
 - 6.10. If requiring a 1 Event Competition Licence, add \$75.00 (per rider) to your entry fee, licence to be collected on the morning of the event
 - 6.11. Entry fee may include day membership to the organising club
7. **CLASSES OF COMPETITION: -**
SA WOMEN'S CUP; EXPERT (yellow line), SPORT, MASTERS (blue), NOVICE, JUNIOR A (white), SUB JUNIOR, MINI TRIAL (run of section)
DIENER/HOLES SIDECAR TROPHY; A GRADE, B GRADE, CLASSIC
B Grade will ride to the black/yellow splits, Classics will have run of section
A Classic Sidecar is defined by having an air-cooled motor and no sidecar wheel brake
SOLO SUPPORT; EXPERT, A, B, C, HISTORIC BLUE, HISTORIC WHITE, CLUBMAN, JUNIOR A, JUNIOR B,
RECREATIONAL; MINI TRIAL AND NON-COMP (SOLO OR SIDECAR)
Junior B is designed for entry level riders and is suitable for small and mid-wheel bikes.
Mini Trial is designed for entry level riders and requires a small wheeled, automatic gearboxed bike and is a non-competitive class.
Dependent on entries, the Historics ride as two separate classes – Blue ride to blue splits, White ride to white splits
Non-Comp riders ride for no Awards or Series Points.

8 AWARDS:

Awards to placegetters in each class dependant on number of competitors.
Recreational and One Event Licence holders may ride any grade section for no awards.

9 ENTRIES TO CONSTITUTE A CLASS:

- 9.1 To constitute a class, the minimum number of contestants entered and competing in each class shall be three (3).
- 9.2 Should there be insufficient entries in any class of competition, the decision to run or cancel the class, or to combine classes and re-distribute any awards, will be at the discretion of the promoter.

10 RIDING FORMAT:

- 10.1 The Trial will be an [ALL DAY RIDE](#), run under "TRIALS" rules. [See point 16; Suggested Timetables.](#)

11 MACHINES AND RIDERS:

- 11.1. All machines entered must comply with the current GCRs for Trials competition.
- 11.2. Machines and competitors must report to machine examination during times shown in the Time Table and produce their MA licence. There is a penalty for lateness, 1 point per minute as per GCR's, penalty shall not apply if you are in line to be examined at time cut off.
- 11.3. No bikes are to be ridden before machine examination.
- 11.4. Bikes may be ridden and maintenance done in the competitor's car park area, BUT AT A WALKING PACE ONLY.
However, refuelling is only allowed in the designated refuelling area and the use of an enviromat is required.
Penalties apply for failure to observe these rules, maximum 100 points or exclusion.
- 11.5. Riders must present their scorecard to the scorer at the completion of each lap (Penalty for each unattempted section is 5 points)
- 11.6. Substitution of Motorcycle may be allowed, subject to the approval of the Clerk Of Course or Steward.
- 11.7. Officials may ride as and when required to perform their duty.
- 11.8. The penalty for attempting a section without the lanyard being attached to the bike and rider shall be five (5) points.

12 NAME PLATES:

- 12.1. All bikes will have name plates which MUST comply with the GCR's.
FOR 2017 THE COLOUR OF NAME PLATES SHALL BE AS FOLLOWS;
GREEN – EXPERT RED – A GRADE SOLO & SIDECAR YELLOW – B GRADE SOLO & SIDECAR
BLUE – C GRADE SOLO & HISTORIC BLUE WHITE – CLUBMAN, HISTORIC WHITE & JUNIOR A
BLACK – JUNIOR B & CLASSIC SIDECAR ORANGE – MINI TRIAL

13 RIDERS' BRIEFING:

- 13.1 A riders' briefing will be held prior to the commencement of riding, which ALL competitors MUST attend.

14 DRUG AND OR ALCOHOL TESTING:

- 14.1. All competitors and officials are advised that as part of the MA and MSA drug education program, drug testing may take place at any competition in accordance with Australian Sports Commission policy as implemented by the Australian Sports Drug Agency and the Motorcycling SA Drug and Alcohol Policy.
- 14.2. If any doubts exist over banned substances it is recommended competitors contact the Drugs in Sport Hotline, tel 1800 020 506. When drug testing takes place, the payment of prizemoney may be delayed at the Motorcycling SA Inc. discretion until the results of the tests are known.

15. CODE OF CONDUCT:

All competitors, officials and parents are reminded of the Motorcycling Australia by-law - CODE OF CONDUCT (as stipulated in the GCRs), which is a guide to appropriate behaviour at all motorcycle race meetings. This CODE OF CONDUCT applies to this Meeting and will be enforced.
